

COVID-19 Mortgage Payment Holidays Guidance

On 17th March the government announced new measures to help those facing financial difficulties during the coronavirus crisis.

Speaking at the news conference, Chancellor Rishi Sunak stated mortgage lenders will offer a three month mortgage payment holiday to those struggling to pay.

Our advice at Complete Mortgages is – a payment holiday should only be taken as a last resort. At the end of a payment holiday the lender will recalculate your monthly payments and the amount you owe will go up. That's because the lender will still add interest to your mortgage while you take a break.

Your individual circumstances will need to be discussed directly with your mortgage lender, and it is worth considering that you may already have an existing mortgage payment holiday policy in place. Please follow the links below for further information.
